Public Notice for Montana Department of Environmental Quality - Opencut Mining Program

To Whom It May Concern:

Jake Yoder plans to begin work in a new opencut gravel pit at 4376 Eastside Highway, legally described as Parcel B2 of CS 700528-R in the NE¼, SE¼, and NW¼ of Section 24, T09N, R20W, in Stevensville, Ravalli County, Montana. The gravel pit operation will occupy a total of 13.1 acres of land owned by Jake Yoder. It is planned to remove approximately 90,000 cubic yards of material over a period of approximately twenty-five years that will be processed and used for construction. A Montana Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) Opencut Mining permit has been applied for. As a part of the permit application process, the operator is required to send a public notice to all property owners located within one-half mile of the proposed boundary of the opencut permit, as well as publish notice of the proposed site twice in a local newspaper and in the proximity of the site.

Currently, the site is open rangeland. The site contains 10-inches of topsoil that will be stockpiled and replaced once mining operations have concluded on the site. Gravels are the materials that will be mined from the site using facilities/equipment such as a crusher, screen(s), grizzly, backhoe, dozer, dump truck, excavator, loader, scraper, skidsteer, and other equipment to mine the site. The site is accessed by starting in Stevensville, MT at the intersection of Main Street and Eastside Highway. Head east on the Eastside Highway and continue where it turns north for approximately 1 mile. The site is currently open rangeland with no access, but one will be constructed once the site is permitted. The attached site map shows the proposed gravel pit operations. Also included with this letter is the MDEQ *Request for Public Meeting* form, which provides information on how surface landowners can request a public meeting to discuss this operation, if desired. The current opencut permitting activities, including reclamation, are planned to be completed by December, 2042. If you have any questions, please contact the operator at the information below.


